



2008 Willamette Valley Estate Pinot Noir

Tasting Notes

With an initial aroma of violets, earth, and spice leading to a ripe cherry and black fruit mid-palate this wine is very representative of this classic vintage. It is full bodied with refreshing acidity that leads to a finish of firm tannins.
