



2009 Willamette Valley Reserve Pinot Noir

Tasting Notes

Opens with aromas of violets and black cherries paired with a smoky toast background that leads to flavors of plum and black fruit through the mid-palate. Balanced acidity gives the wine a clean finish matched with firm tannins.

Commercial yeast fermentation
Full malolactic secondary fermentation
Aged 10 months in French oak, 40% new
