Product Notes: Our Riesling is produced from a nearly 20 year old single acre block at the Kraemer family's vineyard in Mt. Angel, Oregon. The fruit is 100% stainless steel tank fermented to preserve all of the pure fruit character in the finished wine.

Tasting Notes

Leads with aromas of citrus blossoms and apricot that extend to flavors of green apple and lychee. The bright flavors intertwine with a refreshing acidity that finishes with a hint of honey sweetness. Pair with cheese appetizers and spicy Asian dishes.
